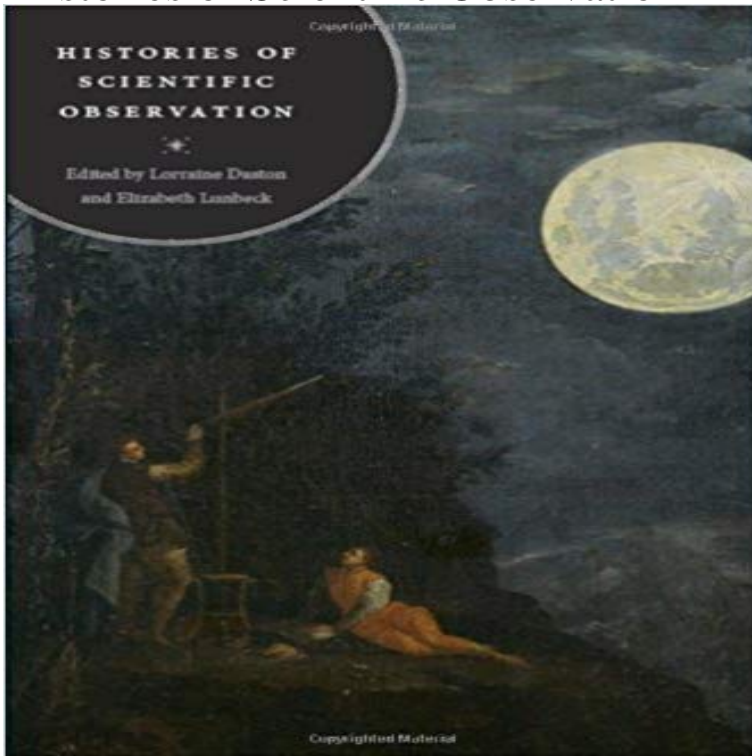


Histories of Scientific Observation
